If you do not have insurance through your job and do not qualify for Medicaid, Connect for Health Colorado is here to help you find a plan that fits your budget. You can only apply for health insurance through Connect for Health Colorado during Open Enrollment unless you experience certain life changing events like losing your Medicaid or your health insurance from your job. The next Open Enrollment Period is **November 1, 2020- January 15, 2021**. Connect for Health Colorado has in-person and virtual help available to you in Denver and Aurora at no cost.
